1. Vendor Fee: Minimum donation of \$30 per table. Space is 10 x 10 and situated on the grass. Please provide your own table, chairs and canopy. There is no electric provided. (*Non-Profit Organizations: FREE*)
2. No refunds.
3. Hours – Set up begins at 9am, registration for public starts at 10am. Breakdown 2-2:30pm
4. Prohibited items and transactions: Gas powered generators; the selling of 50/50 raffle tickets, the selling of Silly (spray) string or any other item which the Walk committee deems unacceptable; solicitation in any form during the Fair; any commercial and/or activities except the selling of crafts or new merchandise; roving vendors; no food vendors, costumed individuals except without prior permission.
5. Locations will be assigned only by the Bark in the Park Committee and such locations will be monitored accordingly. For more info on site selection, call Jim Davidson at (609) 644-2592.
6. The Bark in the Park committee reserves the right to relocate or dismiss any participant or selling activity found not in compliance with the conditions listed.
7. All garbage must be removed from the area by 3pm. Vendors not in compliance will be assessed a clean-up fee.
8. Please be sure to submit a list and short description of the items you plan to sell.
