The Donations Committee and Board have approved a \$1,250 donation to support a local project to create a **Healing Garden** at the **Hunterdon Medical Center**. The project was started by Robert Vanacore, who is a Boy Scout with Troop 194 here in Flemington. The Healing Garden project was created by Mr. Vanacore to help him

earn the honorable rank of Eagle Scout. All of the labor would be donated to construct the garden, but the material costs were estimated to be roughly \$1,740. Flemington Rotary's donation of \$1,250 brings Robert up to his full financial goal to fund the project.




