## MEDIATECH - www.mediatech.org

Warren Buckleitner and Will Richardson presented a brief but informative program on the status of Mediatech. In an effort to provide free access to all age groups, the computer lab has set up 18 high speed computers in the upper floor of the Flemington Library. They now have 520 members signed up, pre-school thru senior. They offer access to over 4000 software titles, including the popular SAT Test Prep for high school students. 17 members per day utilize the equipment which is available from 3 to 7 PM weekdays and noon to 5 PM on Saturdays.

FAME - Flemington Arts & Multimedia Expo This program is a "juried competition designed to showcase the creativity of amateur artists in digital media such as digital photography, video and audio editing and web based design." This will be the first of its kind in the area, just as MEDIATECH was when it began with Flemington Rotary sponsorship in 2002. The steering committee will meet later in January at MEDIATECH in Flemington. Volunteers are needed to help organize and promote the Expo for the Spring of 2008.

Mediatech's goals are the same as our **Four Way Test.** This worthwhile program needs the support of the community which it serves. Flemington Rotary is a Service organization which supports the community and those efforts which improve and enhance the members of our community in need.
