PROGRAM - Audubon Society of New Jersey

Linda Gangi made a presentation of the need for developing sites in Western New Jersey for birding and wildlife trails. The Skylands area is perfect for Ecotourism and outdoor recreation. Nationwide, ecotourism involved 66 million people (about 31% of the population) over the last 10 years, spending over \$40 billion during that same time period.

Linda's mission is to have the individuals recommend sites in Hunterdon, Warren and Sussex counties to be nominated for public for outdoor recreation. After being nominated, the Audubon Society will evaluate the site for safety, reliability of seeing wildlife, and the facilities available at the site. Round Valley and Spruce Run are great birding sites.
