Rotary joins Chamber; attendance guidelines established

Flemington Rotary became a group member of the Hunterdon County Chamber of Commerce in early December. Our membership is a one-year pilot project to determine whether it benefits Rotary's own goals for recruitment and public awareness.

Please be aware that individual Rotary members who are seeking promotion of their own businesses through HCCC events must do so through their own Chamber memberships.

As a Rotary member attending Chamber events, you will be expected to represent Rotary. You must wear your Rotary badge and pin, and when you introduce yourself, you must say that you are a representative of Flemington Rotary.

Since your badge displays your business classification, we expect that some Chamber members will ask what you do outside of Rotary. If that happens, you are free to talk about your classification but please do not hand out your personal business card. You may accept others' business cards and set up appointments accordingly.

Our purpose in joining the Chamber is to promote Rotary, to invite people to lunches, to increase Rotary membership and to gather support for our projects and fundraisers.

A Rotarian may attend any Chamber event as a Rotary representative. If there is a cost, the individual is responsible for payment.

Rotary business cards and informational handouts will be available in January for your use at Chamber events. The Rotary Membership Committee will monitor Rotarian attendance at Chamber events to determine whether the group membership is valuable.

We encourage you to attend as many Chamber events as you can and to help spread the word about Rotary!

Local art institute also a good neighbor

Community service is an ideal for the artistically minded, too! Rotarians learned last week that the Hunterdon Museum of Art has a 15-year-old program for developmentally disabled adults, and 1,000 county children participate in their annual Young Artists Showcase.

Marjorie Frankel Nathanson, executive director of the Hunterdon Museum of Art, was our Dec. 5 guest speaker. She also talked about the museum's lead role in stabilizing the dam and dike along the South Branch of the Raritan River in Clinton Township, where the museum is housed in an 1836 stone grist mill. The dam and the dike protect the town of Clinton and the museum's current fundraising project aims to substantially improve both structures instead of bandaging yearly flood damage.

Scotsman named president-nominee of Rotary Int'l

John Kenny of the Grangemouth Rotary Club in Scotland has been nominated as president of Rotary International for 2009-2010. He will become president-nominee on Dec. 1 if there are no challengers.

A law school dean, judge, and notary, Kenny is active in scouting and earned the Medal of Merit for helping form new scout groups in Eastern Europe. He is an elder of the Church of Scotland and past general legal counsel of Jaycees International.

A Rotarian since 1970, he served Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland as president and vice president. He is a major donor to The Rotary Foundation, a Bequest Society member and recipient of the Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service and Distinguished Service Award.
