## SUPERB PRESENTATIONS FROM DOWN UNDER

The club got a sample of another civilization when five Australian Rotary Exchange professionals gave slide presentations on their jobs, families and general lifestyle. The five were from western Australia, where the biggest city is Perth, and outside the urban areas, the region is generally more "outback" than Flemington.

Lex McKay, the leader of the Australian team, introduced his teammates. He also pointed out that Perth is 12 hours ahead of Flemington timewise, and therefore leads the way whenever anything is happening, making us backward cousins.

He commented that cars in the U.S. "sneak up to you" on the left. But U.S. hospitality is not in doubt; while he and Ian Wallace, a police officer, were out getting something to eat, they got a ride from an American police officer to the right restaurant. He waited for them and took them back to their hotel, where they exchanged patches and took a group photo.

Speaking of hospitality, Lex presented Gwen and Jim with an Australian "Hundred Years of Rotary" medallion minted in western Australia for the good care they have taken of the team. Lex explained that Western Australia Rotary is divided into three districts, largely because of the distances involved.

A printer, he has held many leadership positions in Rotary. He brought a slide of his Heidelberg fully computerized press. He enjoys living on the coast, and the water sports that go with the location. He showed his first love, a 350-V8, six-speed manual shift pickup truck. Lex is an avid scuba diver who has discovered battery powered scooters that give you a speedy underwater ride.

Anita Logiudice's parents immigrated to Australia from Sicily, and upon arrival, began several agricultural enterprises. Anita showed slides of their olive grove and other properties, and last year's cherry crop. Anita is an environmental scientist working for Alcoa A-lu-MIN-i-um. Alcoa has three mine sites and three refineries in Western Australia. Working at one of the refineries, Anita's duties involve promoting environmental responsibility for the plant and environmental training and education for nearby universities, schools and communities.

She and her husband Craig have been married for one year; Craig shares a popular addiction with many Australians, surfing, so Anita brought along a slide of Craig "in the curl." She says it's common in Australia to commute to work or play over an hour from home. She enjoys the beautiful untouched wilderness in Western Australia, and what she says is "some of the best coastline in the world."

Ian Wallace, a police officer in a town SE of Perth, is 39 years old, married with two children, and an air force reservist. As a pilot, he particularly enjoyed an aerial excursion with Dick Solner. His four-bedroom home is provided as part of his job benefits. He said most of their socializing is with other police officers. In Australia, the police are also the prosecutors, so Ian spends a lot of his time doing paperwork and appearing in court.

Melanie Capper's family farms in a small country town about two and a half hours SE of Perth. Its name means "meeting place" and really is, because all the residents of smaller surrounding communities.

But Melanie grew up over five hours SE of Perth in the "real outback" in a community with 50 residents, where everyone in town knew "what everyone else what up to." Her family's 8,000-acre farm raises mainly wheat and barley. The "lawn service" consists of sheep. The landscape is distinguished with many grain storage elevators, similar to the midwestern US.

Because this area gets only 12 inches of rain per year, they collect water from the house and shed roofs, store it, then use it for washing. Being at the "end of the line" their electricity cuts out frequently, so they use a generator.

She is a classroom teacher who has always had a love for little people. Formerly a Catholic school teacher, she now teaches lower socio-economic kids, many of them "new Australians," in a government school. Twenty five percent are Aboriginal with many others speaking foreign languages.

Donna Hobbey's parents have a 3,000-acre farm. Typical for Australia, Donna enjoys many sports and enjoys watching sports. She is a health commission officer whose job is to help in the prevention of disease. She teaches courses, runs workshops and does screenings over a wide geographical area.

In order to reach the population "where they live," she goes to car shows, motorcycle shows, farm shows and other events typical of western Australia. At car shows, her "Pit Stop" program attracts men to the booth where, posing as an "auto technician," she compares blood to oil, and other body parts to parts of cars, in order to give attendees a good understanding of their health.

Lex completed the team's presentation by thanking the group's hosts and transporters, as well as our district's officers, for a wonderful time. Banners were swapped!

Next year's Group Study Exchange is with Greece. We will send one Rotarian team leader and 4 non-Rotarians team members who are 25 to 40 years old. Gwen has applications!


