# **GUEST SPEAKER**

Dan Kerr, principal of the Hunterdon County Polytech, joined us to speak about his pilgrimage to Kenya with an organization known as Earthwatch Institute. Earthwatch Institute is an international non-profit organization that brings science to life for people concerned about the Earth's future. Founded in 1971, Earthwatch supports scientific field research by offering volunteers the opportunity to join research teams around the world.

Dan gave a brief synopsis of the research of the Samburu Culture in Africa. The research team gathered information on marriages, education, health concerns, communities, water and wildlife studies.

For the people of Kenya's semiarid Samburu region, water is a precious commodity. People and livestock compete with wildlife for water, and in the dry season water sources can easily become contaminated. To address these issues, scientists are working on a major project called Water in The Community. The methods of research are hiking in riverbeds, testing water for microorganisms, digging wells and doing lab work on the samples taken. The outcome of the lab work detected water borne pathogens in 95% of the samples taken. The samples contained E.Coli and Simonella. Wells are dug 3-4 feet deep to provide water to natives who hike three to five miles for water.
