4. Make up missed meetings within **14** days, before or after absence.

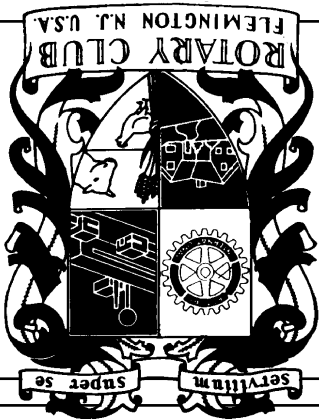
