PROGRAM - PRIZM

Desiree Ficula presented a program on Human Rights Education through Rutgers University's Douglas College. This Global Program is designed to promote awareness of human rights issues at home and abroad. It makes human rights education accessible to women of all economic, ethnic and social background by providing a safe place for young women (14-18) to discuss these topics at no cost to themselves. The concept is to cultivate leadership by encouraging women to take social action.

PRIZM'S Vision is to create a safe place in which young women may initiate the dialogue that serves as a catalyst for social action. Through retreats, PRIZM hopes to provide the space and support for young women to learn about human rights through interaction and develop their own social action projects. 4. Make up missed meetings within **14** days, before or after absence.

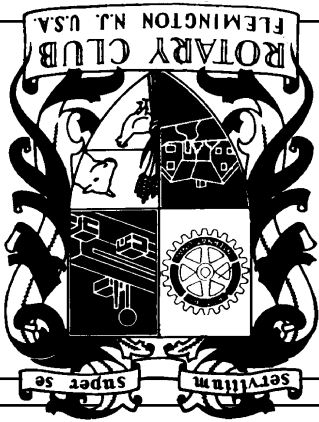
