PROGRAM

Mick Schaible presented a beautiful slide show of the Homes of Hope project in Ecuador. This Rotary International project is also one of our clubs International efforts. The current thrust is to get portable drinking water to the homes, convert the hut bamboo walls to cement block, and to provide proper sanitation facilities for the village.

The water project is underway using funds that our club provided with matching grants from Rotary International and District 7510. The original estimation for laying the 3 miles of pipe was over \$20,000. But through discussion with the Town of San Pablo and their water authority, the cost was cut in half. The back hoe has been rented and the trenching has begun.


