He thanked the club members who provided the leadership that brought the 4th annual event to such a successful conclusion. Bob reported that with just a few sponsors outstanding, the club should net about \$15,000 which includes the proceeds from the 50/50 raffle. Heather Brisby won 1st Prize which was 25% of sales = \$3,130; Bonnie Duncan won 2nd Prize, 15% of sales = \$1,878; and Louise Kinsella won 3rd Prize, 10% of sales = \$1,252. With sales of 626 chances of a possible 1000, the club's net is \$6,260.

Terry Ownes announced that the Ownes family is off to Europe for 10 days with a Mediterranean influence.

### **PROGRAM**

Bill Mealia was our guest speaker last week. He is a member and past president of the Elizabeth Rotary Club and is the Chairman of the Polio Plus Committee for District 7510. Bill is a Polio survivor having contracted the dreadful disease in 1947 at the age of 7.

In 1985, Rotary International in concert with the UN and the World Health Organization undertook a fundraising campaign to wipe out polio, worldwide. **247 million dollars** was raised by 1987. Over the last 20 years, a hands on campaign to the 122 nations worldwide results in virtually ridding the world of the disease. Polio is still a major problem in 4 countries: Pakistan, Afghanistan, India and Nigeria.

The final push is underway. Our district has a goal of \$15,000. Polio Piggies (blue piggy banks) were distributed earlier and they need to be fed. Use them to empty your pockets or purses every night. Not just the pennies, nickels and dimes, but those quarters also. It'll keep your clothes from being so heavy. Don't be afraid to put in some paper money too. Let's show the world that we have an interest in eliminating polio from the Earth.
