## **Hooray for Flemington Food Pantry!**

By early 2009, the Flemington Area Food Pantry will move (at long last!) to larger quarters in the new Wal-Mart complex. Club member Tom Cunningham, who's also president of the Food Pantry, said Wal-Mart offered a 4,000-square-foot building behind its main store. The 50-year deal comes with a one dollar annual lease and a 25-year option to extend.

Initially, said Tom, the building will be a shell and up to \$200,000 will be needed for final construction and furnishing. The move will allow a much-needed increase in refrigerator and freezer capacity since the new building is larger by 1,000 square feet than the current building at 110 Broad Street.

"At Thanksgiving we might get 100 turkeys all at once and there's just not enough room to store them," said Tom.

Flemington Rotary contributes roughly \$2,000 per year in canned goods or straight donations to the Food Pantry, which serves people throughout Hunterdon County. In addition, the club has given \$5,000 toward the building fund.

About 2,000 people per month, including many families, are served by the Food Pantry. The monthly food cost averages \$10,000.

### **Rotary buys heart pump for Raritan police**

With its nimble traffic maneuvers, a police motorcycle can often get to an emergency before the first aid squad. With that in mind, Rotary has donated an automated external defibrillator, or AED, to the Raritan Township Police Department so their lone motorcycle officer can carry it at all times.

Club member DJ Wright generated that brainstorm while working on our first annual Ride for Rotary motorcycle fundraiser. He learned the department didn't have money for an AED and figured: What better use for proceeds from a motorcycle event? At last week's club meeting, police and township officials joined us for an AED demonstration and DJ gave a plaque bearing the Rotary insignia to Chief Glen Tabasco.
