Spoons Ready, But No Slurping!

Flemington Rotary's first annual Hunterdon County Soup Cook-Off is set for Wednesday, Mar. 19, from 5 to 8 p.m. at Hunterdon County Polytech. As a goodwill community project, the cook-off will be a chance for amateur chefs to compete for prizes using their favorite family recipes.

Dozens of crockpots filled with delicious soups will line the cafeteria tables, accompanied by salads, breads and desserts. For \$5 per person, tasters from across the county will be invited to sample as many soups as they like, then vote for their top choice.

First prize will be \$250 cash and second and third prizes will be gift certificates to local restaurants.

Flyers and posters are in the works along with a program of publicity. Each club member will be tasked with finding viable public locations to display two posters (i.e., your own business, a friend's business, a church, restaurant, etc.)

Starting next year, the cook-off will be scheduled on annual Rotary Day, Feb. 23. (Too little time to pull if off for this year's Rotary Day.) The cook-off is being planned by Lisa Brady (chair) and Robin Patric of the Public Relations Committee.

Doin' Our Part for Rotary Day

Mick Schaible will star in a local cable TV program about his role in rebuilding an Ecuadorian village with Rotary International. The half-hour program on local cable channel 14 is being filmed to recognize Rotary Day, Feb. 23, 2008.

The program moderator, our own Lisa Brady, will frame the interview in the context of RI's global community involvement, noting Mick's membership in Flemington Rotary and the club's support of his activism. The program will touch on local students and community folks who have contributed to the project and/or traveled with Mick to Ecuador to provide hands-on rebuilding assistance.

As a related fundraiser, Flemington Central's Interact Club will organize the Rotary Day "Penny Wars." Groups of students will toss coins in wide-mouthed containers, competing for the largest collection. The winners will earn a special group prize, such as an ice cream party in the school cafeteria. All Penny Wars proceeds will come to Flemington Rotary for use in community projects.

Advance media publicity is planned to announce the cable program.
