The Rotary Foundation has named a new class of Rotary World Peace Fellows to study peacemaking and conflict resolution at the six Rotary Centers for International Studies located at universities in England, Japan, Australia, Argentina, and the United States.

Launched in 2002, this innovative approach to world peace is a master's level program aimed at equipping the next generation to reduce the threat of war and violence. Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to peace and international understanding through their personal and community service activities or academic and professional achievements.

The 60 students in the 2008-2010 class represent 33 countries. Their areas of expertise include public health, education, international law, economic development, psychology, journalism, and social justice.


