Go back to the 50s for Rotary radio drama

Thirteen radio dramas from 1955, the Rotary Golden Theater Radio Show, are now available online in recorded and transcript versions. Rotary International produced the segments in 1955 as a 50th anniversary commemoration.

Each segment offers a valuable lesson in living based on Rotary principles, such as episode 6, "Dear Enemy," which questions whether a business competitor is an enemy or a partner in promoting good industry practices. After meeting a Rotarian, one businessman finds the answer.

In episode 7, "Worthy Work," a wealthy man's heart attack during a snowstorm helps him see the worthiness of all occupations. In episode 8, "Honor Among Thieves," a businessman discovers uncomfortable truths after a conversation with a man considered dishonest by many in town.

What you permit, you promote

Outside lunches are fine as long as everyone cleans up after themselves. Cell phones and iPods are okay if students uses them respectfully.

It all comes down to a simple adage: "What you permit, you promote." Last Wednesday, Hunterdon Central High School Principal Christina Steffner described several new programs that give the school's students new privileges. By accepting them responsibly, the students' reward is continued privilege.

For example, morning bus drop-offs are being handled in a new way. In the past, 80 buses amassed outside the school, waiting until 7:30 a.m. to simultaneously release 3,200 kids. It was a policy to avoid the potential abuses of idle time. This year, students can enter the school as early as 7 a.m., as long as they use the time productively -- eat breakfast, see a coach or teacher, study in the library, chat in an appropriate place with friends -- then get to class on time.

Another initiative came about because of students using cell phones and iPods in classrooms, showing disrespect for teachers and fellow students. Rather than banning the devices altogether, the school now permits their use during eight-minute breaks between classes and at lunch, but not in classrooms.
