## **Soup Cook-Off Goes Pro**

All five Hunterdon County Rotary clubs will be involved in planning this year's Hunterdon County Soup Cook-Off and the focus will change from amateur to professional chefs. Planners expect to double last year's attendance of 175 tasters.

The 2008 inaugural event showcased the cooking talents of 50 home chefs and the friendly competition was hailed as a soul- and belly-warming success. For next year, planners are heeding government regulations on sales of home-cooked foods in a public venue. Instead, the 2009 event will feature professional chefs from restaurants across the county. Twenty-five chefs will each provide a minimum five gallons of soup. (Last year's chefs brought one gallon containers.)

A simultaneous contest will be held for up to 10 student chefs enrolled in school-based culinary programs.

A two-tiered judging process will include public votes and a panel of five Rotarian judges, one each from the five county clubs.

The event is scheduled for Rotary Day, Monday, Feb. 23, at Hunterdon Central High School.

### **New Wetlands Emerge in Our Midst**

Two acres of new wetland will be created next year along Walnut Brook in Raritan Township, all of it enhanced by hundreds of new plantings. Grace Messinger, guest speaker at last week's meeting, said her agency, the North Jersey Resource Conservation and Development Council, has developed a restoration project to stabilize 670 feet of streambank from Mine Brook Park to Dvoor Farm.

Part of the work is already completed. A \$51,000 project in the park itself included stabilizing the stream bank that was severely undercut by erosion and hazardous to people using the park. The walkway along the stream was moved back, the embankment was tapered and stabilized with stone, and native plantings were added.

Similar work will be completed downstream from the park and into the Dvoor Farm. The newly created wetlands will provide an improved wildlife habitat as will the new native trees and bushes.
