<u>Max Berkowitz</u>: It is with deep sympathy that I share the news that Max Berkowitz passed away this past Sunday, July 31 at the age of 89. As many of you know, Max was a member of Flemington Rotary for a number of years. Max was a great member of the club and was always willing to lend a hand for our many projects. Max's daughter, Harriet Schneiderman, noted that Max "took great pride in what the organization accomplished - to the point of having perfect attendance 14 out of 15 years. And, he's won the Man of the Year Award and the Paul Harris Award." Bob Wise noted that Max's pleasant demeanor and positive view of life were the qualities that he will remember. Funeral services are today (Tues, 8/2) at 12 noon at Bernheim Apter Funeral Chapel, 68 Old Short Hills Rd, Livingston, NJ.

Below is Max's Obituary as it appeared today on NJ.com via the Hunterdon County Democrat:

RARITAN TWP. — Max Berkowitz died Sunday, July 31, 2011 at Daughters of Israel Geriatric Center in West Orange. He was 89.

Born and raised in Paterson, Mr. Berkowitz was raised in West Amwell Township and resided in Raritan Township most of his life. He was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Army.

He operated a poultry farm with his brother, Abe, in West Amwell. A graduate of Delaware Valley College of Agriculture and Science in Doylestown, Pa., he then worked for the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Farmers Home Administration for more than 22 years, retiring in 1988.

He was an agricultural loan specialist and served as assistant director of the district office in Flemington for 10 years. Earlier he was assistant supervisor of the Atlantic County office and then supervisor of the Hunterdon County office.

He was a long-time member of the Flemington Rotary, who received the Rotarian of the Year Award in 1988 and also received the Rotary's Paul Harris Fellow Award.

Mr. Berkowitz is survived by his beloved wife Eleanor (nee Gilinsky); his daughter Harriet Schneiderman and her husband Bart; and his grandson, Jason Schneiderman.


