The Commons is near Hunterdon Central’s field house located at 29 Junction Road, Flemington, NJ 08822.

Rotary is continuing their “spooked” up menu with their **Boo-Berry** & **Count Chocula** Pancakes for all ages to enjoy!!!!

This year’s special activities will include an indoor **Halloween High School**, sponsored by Hunterdon Central as a “thank you” to the community for their support of the high school. The Halloween High School is free to kids Kindergarten through Grade 3 from 10am to 12noon. There will be Haunted House decorated hallways, children's scary story time and all kinds of Halloween activities and games in different classrooms. Kids and their parents can come together and there will be prizes and gifts to families and kids who come in costume. “We are pleased to be able to partner with Flemington Rotary during their popular Pancake Day,” said Acting Superintendent Chris Steffner. “Parents can enjoy a pancake breakfast while their little ones have a chance to enjoy some Halloween fun with our high school students and staff. 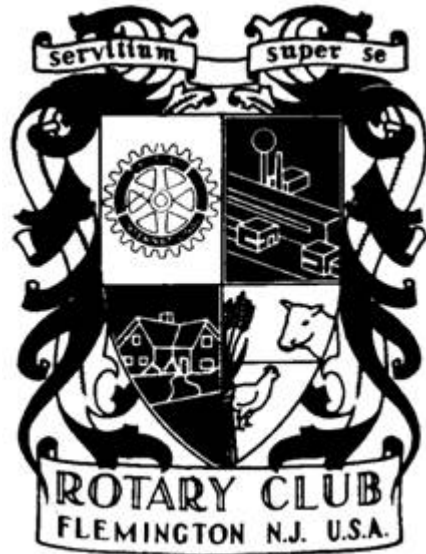
